Important COVID update regarding face coverings and continued COVID testing in school.

<u>Face Coverings in school</u> - Until Saturday 2nd April 2022, the Corona Care Ordinance states an obligation to wear a mask in all interior rooms of schools in NRW. After that, the obligation ends and face coverings are no longer required in school from Monday 4th April 2022.

However, especially for the last week before the Easter holidays, every student and everyone working in our school is free to wear a mask voluntarily in the school buildings if they wish.
