#### 7. Risk Awareness

- No access to specialist services (SEND) and an increase in pupil need and number on roll, results in supportability issues. School will be, and has supported a number of pupils deemed unsupportable by DCS.
- Potential delay in MASO timelines due to DCS absence of Educational Psychologists and Speech & Language therapists. Impact on particular postings to Sennelager with future growth.
- Budget reductions and severely limited face-to-face CPD opportunities for teaching team.
- Staffing structure and limited capacity to endure absence, or support wider DCS programmes/meetings/CPD.
- LEC post holders fulfilling multiple job roles limited cover options for teacher absence. Increased pressure on Headteacher to cover teaching and site maintenance requirements.
- DIO 2-3 year project delivery timeline self-help for infra projects required e.g. 2-3 provision and potential KS3 expansion delay.

- Continued academic success see data analysis (DCS Core Visit / Juniper National Benchmarking)
  Years 1-6 School Attainment: Reading 91.4% / National Benchmark 70.6%; Writing 67.2% / National
  Benchmark 61.8% and Mathematics 87.9% / National Benchmark 71.6%.
- Internal CPD Walkthru programme for teaching and support colleagues started in January 2024- 5 weekly improvement cycles.
